Parents of Woodson High School Students,

On behalf of the Woodson Community Coalition, welcome to Woodson High School for the 2009-2010 school year!

The Woodson Community Coalition is in place to proactively support our parents and students regarding alcohol and drug abuse on our campus and in our community. We are one of many parent-led Community Coalitions who are active throughout Fairfax County schools. We are committed to offering educational seminars and other helpful information to our parents and students on the critical issue of alcohol and drug abuse.

The consequences for not engaging proactively on this topic are serious. Far too many students have lost their lives due to underage drinking or drug abuse. According to the Virginia Alcohol Laws, it is illegal for anyone under 21 to possess any alcoholic beverage. It is also illegal for adults to allow (aid and abet) underage persons to possess or consume alcohol. This includes purchasing and/or providing the alcohol. These violations are Class 1 Misdemeanors and penalties upon conviction can include a \$2,500 fine per young person provided any alcoholic beverage, loss of the adult's driver's license for up to one year, and/or up to one year in jail. Teens can lose their driver's license for up to a full year and incur a mandatory minimum \$500 fine (up to \$2500) for buying, consuming or possessing any alcoholic beverage. Virginia has a Zero Tolerance Law making driving under the influence of any amount of alcohol a serious criminal offense for drivers under age 21.

We are looking forward to working with you this school year in partnership to proactively address alcohol and drug abuse prevention and awareness at Woodson High School and in our community.
