George Mason U, a much more expensive alternative site (which would increase senior fees), would disallow Woodson's technology needs for deaf and hard of hearing students. *Parent suggestion:* reserve seats for parents and use spillover for friends.

*B. Staffing*—Need Spanish and Work Awareness Training teachers. Hired Amanda Foley as new assistant principal (DHOH) to replace Ms. Kannapell.

*C. Classes*—Had to cancel Latin I and a few business classes (low enrollment).

*A.* Provided background on proposed New Parking Area (NPA) for 51 buses at W. T. Woodson High School and on Eleven Oaks facility:
